	Low	10-year limited	None; naturally weathers to a silver-gray if left untreated	Clean with mild soap and water; let dry. To maintain original color, regularly apply deck oil such as Cutek Extreme Wood Protection Oil	2:1 mix of water and vinegar/add some dish soap. Use brush to scrub surfaces. Rinse and let dry. Wipedown with 3% hydrogen peroxide which will foam and disinfect
	None	20-year limited that also covers splitting, fungal decay and insect damage		Clean with mild soap and water	Wipe with disinfecting wipes or 70% isopropyl Alcohol
	Low	7-year against rusting, peeling, chip or cracking, mold, mildew, fading and defects in materials and/or workmanship		Clean with mild soap and water	Wipe with disinfecting wipes or 70% isopropyl Alcohol. Please Note: Chlorine Bleach may cause surface discoloration
	Low	3-year against rusting, peeling, chip or cracking, mold, mildew, fading and defects in materials and/or workmanship; 7-year against fading		Clean with mild soap and water	Wipe with disinfecting wipes or 70% isopropyl Alcohol. Please Note: Chlorine Bleach may cause surface discoloration
	Low	5-year limited	None	Clean with mild soap and water	Spray with 3%-6% Hydrogen Peroxide. Please Note: Peroxide is recommended for natural stone because of the foaming action
	Low	20-year limited	None on stainless steel or Aluminum; 7-year on galvanized steel	Use non-abrasive cleaner that is formulated for stainless steel or aluminum; Clean galvanized steel with mild soap and water	Wipe with 70% isopropyl alcohol. 3%-6% Hydrogen Peroxide may also be used on stainless steel. Please Note: Chlorine Bleach will cause corrosion and surface discoloration
	Moderate	5-year limited	2-year on Super Durables powder coat finish; 1-year limited on powder coats	Remove loose surface deposits with wet sponge. Using soft brush, mild detergent and warm water, remove dust and other deposits; rinse thoroughly	Please Note: Chlorine Bleach will cause corrosion and surface discoloration
